City walking tour 3,5 km (2 miles) 08:30 – 12:00

Prague is one of the best "Eastern" European cities you could imagine. Architecturally, and in terms of city sights, it is a revelation with some 600 years of architecture virtually untouched by natural or war disaster.

Large part of medieval Prague is pedestrian area with no coach access.

We walk downhill from the Castle through 14th century Charles Bridge passing famous Old Town Square with Astronomical clock . Our walk continue towards the boat, where we enjoy our lunch with cruise.

You will be able to meet farmers, breeders, veterinarians and other experts and to see presentations of innovations, products and technologies. At the show will be presented around 350 heads of beef cattle of various beef breeds, including 70 heads of the Charolais cattle from top Czech breeders.



The palace of Lednice began its life as a Renaissance villa; in the 17th century it became a summer residence of the ruling Princes of Liechtenstein.. In 1846–58 it was extensively rebuilt in a neo-gothic style .

The surrounding park contains a range of artificial medieval ruins and solitary sixty-metre minaret, reputedly the tallest outside the Muslim world at the time of its construction (1797–1804).

Bratislava - Slovakia

Bratislava offers an inviting glimpse of central European history, architecture and culture. The **capital city of Slovakia** is just about 60 km north-east from Vienna and a short drive from both Hungary and the Czech Republic. It has an incredible **location along the banks of the Danube River**, on the border of the Carpathian Mountains with its rich vineyards.

Bratislava has **2000 years of rich history** dating back to Celtic times. It has been part of the Roman Empire, over centuries attracted royal families such as the Habsburgs and has seen coronations of Hungarian kings including the empress Maria Theresa. However, the last century was not kind to Bratislava. Its multiculturalism and charm was damaged during World War II, followed by 40 years of communism. In the course of these years many have forgotten Bratislava's legendary past.

Recently the city has undergone a great reconstruction and cultural reawakening and made an amazing comeback, turning into a **favorite city break destination** with the Old Town freshly renovated. Tourists are rediscovering the city's charming baroque Old Town and gothic treasures, stylish restaurants, inviting cafes and teeming night life.

Our tour bring is to Bratislava Castle with magnificent view above Danube River and to the Old Town

From the boat we can admire magnificent Davin Castle ruin on Moravia and Danube river confluence. We cruise though Donau Auen National Park, where we have opportunity to observe See Eagles, White and Black Storks and many other interesting wildlife. Going through town of Hainburg we will see large Hainburg Castle and Braunsberg Hill with former Celtic settlement.

12:00 transfer to Schoenbrunn Palace, stroll in magnificent Schoenbrunn Garden Schoenbrunn Palace. Emperor Franz Joseph, who reigned from 1848 to 1916, was born here in 1830. This former summer residence of the imperial family is considered one of the most beautiful baroque palaces in Europe.

The city's unique location makes it one of the most beautiful cities in the world. The hills of Buda and the flat plain of Pest are separated by the sweeping meander of the river which is still blue today on fresh, spring days. Caves, healing thermal springs, nature reserves – and all this in a bustling capital of 2 million people. Among the monuments there is a Roman amphitheatre, genuine Turkish baths, and the special Hungarian variation of Art Nouveau. Many of the capital's splendours have been awarded UNESCO Heritage status and protection. Participants will be shown a good selection of beautiful sights of this

capital, situated on both banks of the river Danube, with a sweeping history that goes back more than 2000 years.

Main attraction in Pest side: Heroes' Square, the City Park, Castle, St. Stephen's Basilica, House of Parliament.

Main attraction in Buda side: Buda is the older, more historic and more scenic part of the capital. The main attraction here is the Castle Hill, with its breath-taking view over the city and its many historic and cultural monuments, such as the 13th century Matthias Church, the Royal Castle or the Fishermen's Bastion.
