During Hana's career she has experienced a wide range of EU and international cannabis policy work, NGO education work, and forprofit organisations. Her company Hempoint, founded in 2010, farms and processes organic hemp, as well as producing and distributing a variety of hemp food and animal feed products. Hempoint is heavily engaged in distribution of EU registered hemp seed varieties internationally and provides consulting for farmers, companies and stakeholders. Hempoint provides a vehicle for policy work with various non-profit organisations including: FAAAT, and the publishing of the UN book Cannabis and Sustainable development. Since 2018 Hana has been president of



the <u>CzecHemp</u> cluster which is the leading association involved in the strategy of hemp and cannabis policy development in the Czech Republic. In early 2022 Hana co-founded the new company KonopiUS to support the US farmers with high quality fibre and grain seeds from registered EU hemp varieties.

Arrival to Hanfthal village

Tour of the village and the hemp museum.

The name of the village Hanfthal ("Hemp Valley"), first recorded in writing in 1149 as "Haniftal", is demonstrably derived from the hemp plant (German Hanf), which was grown in this area. Cultivation of hemp occurs in contemporary texts of gift deeds such as "Hanif". It is obvious that the municipal pond at the time in the middle of the circular village was used for soaking hemp in preparation for processing it into fiber.

We thank the researcher Friedrich Winna for these findings, who wrote down the history of the village of Hanfthal during his decadeslong research work. His Hanftal chronicle



was also the basis for a three-day historical celebration of the 850th anniversary of the foundation of the village in 1999. About 10,000 people visited this impressive holiday. The topic here was also hemp, which gave the village its name.

On the occasion of the construction of the adjacent children's playground, the municipality renovated the ice cream shop building and gave the exhibition a dignified framework. The Hemp Museum aims to help this multifaceted plant, which has accompanied, clothed, nourished and inspired people for centuries, gain the reputation it deserves.

The educational trail which leads around the village speaks to visitors about the history of the village and also all different kind of uses of hemp on only in past but also modern applications.

Visit <u>Hanfland shop/vinery</u>. Hanfland is hemp food company who build their business on the name of the Hanfland village. They have been contracting local farmers for growing hemp since 2004 and created from hemp a valuable commodity for their region. Their hemp is used in own retail brand of organic food or feed products and they been working also many years on development own small scale processing technology for hemp straw.

Short transfer to

Naporo company - hemp insulation

Naporo produce natural insulations panels from whole hemp straw for building industry and acoustics purposes. They process more than 3000 tons of hemp straw annually from Austria and Czech contacted farmers (also from Hanftal area). Interesting technology where expensive decortication step to monetise hemp straw is not needed. Their product meets all EU quality certifications for commercial building requirements.

DAY 3 FRI APR 21 FROM AUSTRIA TO SOUTH BOHEMIA

Short transfer to Heidenreichstein: tour in <u>Hanfland</u> company - organic hemp food processing plant to see the technologies for hemp dehulling, oil pressing, protein production and much more. Hanfland process production from more than 400 ha of their contacted famers. They are well known hemp pioneers not only in Austria region but across whole EU.

30 mins transfer to **<u>Drumparam</u>** – visit of hemp instruments company

All their musical instruments – didgeridoos, jambe or guitars are made from the ecological material called hemp stone. The material allows applications to form with computer-aided calculations to create instruments with special requirements.

In the village of Obermühle we visit workshops and studios of Robert Preissler, natural and organic raw materials are processed and high-quality natural products are lovingly handcrafted. Wollwerk processes wool from sheep, alpacas and llamas into fleece and felt. In the textile workshop, mattresses, blankets and cushions or upholstery. In their showroom, you will also find natural fabrics, wool and felt, as well as products from Waldviertel artists, designers and craftsmen.

HEMP CONFERENCE BRNO

Visit of the education event in Brno - annual conference called Cannabis & Science. First conference started at The Mendel University in 2014 and since that was focused on cannabinoids and medical purpose of cannabis. At 2019 the conference moved to bigger independent location at Brno Observatory and Planetarium.

The year 2023 the conference would be extended in two days, and second day would be dedicated to industrial hemp and all different material application. The host of the conference would be experts involved in hemp cultivation (Hemp and flax research institute Agritec), hemp processing (Tatham or Cormatex company),



hemp builders (Mabeko, Kobe-cz or Dunagrogroup). The food part of the plant would be presented by representant from National food research institute and The University of Chemistry and Technology, Prague.

The conference is simultaneously translated from Czech to English.



Bratislava - Slovakia

Bratislava offers an inviting glimpse of central European history, architecture and culture. The capital city of Slovakia is just about 60 km north-east from Vienna and a short drive from both Hungary and the Czech Republic. It has an incredible location along the banks of the Danube River, on the border of the Carpathian Mountains with its rich vineyards.

Bratislava has **2000 years of rich history** dating back to Celtic times. It has been part of the Roman Empire, over centuries attracted royal families such as the Habsburgs and has seen coronations of Hungarian kings including the empress Maria Theresa. However, the last



century was not kind to Bratislava. Its multiculturalism and charm was damaged during World War II, followed by 40 years of communism. In the course of these years many have forgotten Bratislava's legendary past.

Recently the city has undergone a great reconstruction and cultural reawakening and made an amazing comeback, turning into a **favorite city break destination** with the Old Town freshly renovated. Tourists are rediscovering the city's charming baroque Old Town and gothic treasures, stylish restaurants, inviting cafes and teeming night life.

The main attraction here is the Castle Hill, with its breath-taking view over the city and its many historic and cultural monuments, such as the 13th century Matthias Church, the Royal Castle or the Fishermen's Bastion.
